



TO: Parents of St. Victor School Students

RE: Changes to Calendar for the remainder of the year

We will be following the School District of Monroe in changing our calendar to meet state requirements of instructional time. This is due to the winter weather we have had and St. Victor School closing for the NCEA convention in April. I wanted to highlight the changes AS OF NOW (these would change depending upon any more dates altered by weather)

STARTING Monday April 15 until June 5 we will be adding an additional 5 minutes to each school day. Dismissal for St. Victor School will now be 3:15. This includes additional 5 minutes to 4K students as well.

STARTING Monday April 15 until June 5 there will be NO EARLY RELEASE DAYS on Mondays. Dismissal time will be 3:15 pm.

STARTING Monday April 15 students in 4K will be attending school Monday through Friday. They will be adding 5 minutes to their schedule: AM Class: 8:10-11:15, PM Class: 12:10-3:15. We will need to add a few more days to 4K due to the fact that we are losing days in April for the Teacher Convention. When we have that schedule firmly created we will let families know.

A reminder that there is NO SCHOOL for St. Victor School only on Monday, April 22 through Wednesday, April 24. We will be attending a national convention in Chicago during those days.

The final day of school of all students (4K included) remains on Wednesday, June 5 but now dismissal will be at 3:15 pm instead of the scheduled half-day.
