PRICE LIST

SINGLE GRAVE SPACE

- \$700 Parishioners
- \$875 Non-parishioners
- \$150 Baby Section (max. 3' long)

Price includes the right to be buried in this particular space, the foundation, and perpetual maintenance/care. A single grave space accommodates one full burial or cremated remains. With additional costs for the second right of burial (50% of the cost of grave), the space may accommodate two cremations, or cremated remains above an existing full casket.

All graves will have foundations poured by cemetery personnel once a year.

There will be a 25% surcharge for non-parishioners.

Applicable interment charges must be added to the price of the grave at the time of burial.

INTERMENT CHARGES

- Full Burial - Weekdays \$750
- Full Burial - Saturday \$850
- Full Burial - Holiday/Sunday \$1,000
- Cremains - Weekdays \$350
- Cremains - Saturday \$450
- Cremains - Holiday/Sunday \$550
- Baby Section (max. 3' long) No charge
- DISINTERMENT** \$1,500

NOTE: A winter surcharge of \$150 is assessed from December 1 to March 31.

RULES & REGULATIONS

The scheduling of funerals, funeral luncheons, and burials must take into consideration previously scheduled events, particularly wedding activities if on a Saturday. Cemetery services should be scheduled at least 2-3 days in advance of the desired time of service.

All graveside services should begin by 2:00 pm.

Ordinarily, there will be no interments on Sundays, holy days, holidays, Good Friday, December 24, and December 31. These are special days in the church year, and personnel may not always be available. If exceptions are made, the interment charges will be treated as Holiday/Sunday charges.

The sexton must be contacted for all grave sales and interment arrangements. Opening and closing of any interment site may only be performed by our cemetery.

Cremated remains must be placed in an urn/burial vault made of durable materials (i.e., concrete, marbelon, fiberglass) to ensure that the ground at the burial site does not settle nor sink under the maintenance equipment. Sinking can cause the family's monument to sink, shift, or become damaged. For these reasons, a vault is required to preserve the beauty of the cemetery.

No planting of flowers, shrubs, or trees is allowed.

No glass or ceramic items due to possible safety hazards.

Families or friends should **remove all decorations/items from graves by April 15 and by October 15**. Cemetery personnel will remove all remaining decorations during the semi-annual cleaning.

Spring Cleaning: April 15-30

Fall Cleaning: October 15-31

New decorations are allowed only after each cleaning is completed (after April 30 and after October 31).

HEADSTONE POLICY

Catholic cemeteries are consecrated ground, and all markers placed on consecrated ground must reflect and enhance the Catholic faith and may not detract from it in any way. If any symbols are used, Christian symbolism must be predominant. Provided a Christian symbol is predominant, other symbols may be used that reflect deep and abiding human values, such as family, country, nature, and work. Anything pertaining to hobbies, pets, or trivial pursuits are discouraged and should first have written permission of the pastor and/or cemetery sexton. Calvary Cemetery forbids anything anti-Christian, offensive, racy, or tasteless.

The foundation poured is 42" wide per grave space. The headstone's maximum width is 36" for a single space or 78" for a double space. Also consider leaving room for any permanent bronze vases or decorations/flowers.
